



El Bajío - Reserva Especial Red

This wine comes from Bernal Valley, in Querétaro, Mexico. The unique geo-climate conditions here result in an extreme viticulture, which, in turn, translates to high quality wines.

GRAPES: 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Tempranillo, 20% Merlot, 10% Malbec, 10% Syrah, 3% Marselan

TASTING NOTES:

Bright purple with hints of red on the edges.

A highly aromatic wine with predominant notes of spice, red fruits, hibiscus, blueberries, plums, cherry, blackberries, and figs. On the palate, this wine is dry with notes of cocoa, tobacco, coffee, and chocolate. The elegant texture on the palate is enhanced with silky, balanced tannins. Long and harmonious finish with hints of ripe black fruits and spices.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Excellent accompaniment to seasoned dishes, red game meats, stews, a cheese and charcuterie board, specially Serrano ham
