

ROSÉ

Los vinos rosados se distinguen por sus colores que pueden ir desde un color “ojo de perdiz” a un salmonado, a un rojo cereza pálido hasta un rosado firme.

No hay predilección para ninguna variedad de no ser que el vino venga de una región específica reconocida, sobre todo del viejo continente.

Los rosados son vinos de temporada, consumidos principalmente en el periodo primavera-verano.

Nuestro vino ROSÉ se elabora con 4 uvas vinificadas por separado y ensambladas al final de la fermentación alcohólica. Pinot Noir 25%, Pinot Meunier 25%, Grenache 40% y Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, todas cultivadas en el Valle de Guadalupe.

Color

Clear and bright salmon pink with high intensity.

Aroma

Intensos aromas a fresa madura, cítricos como naranja roja, kiwi y rosas.

Sabor

Un vino seco, con una acidez integrada de cuerpo medio, se repiten las notas a fresa y cítricos. armónico y con buena persistencia.

Brix promedio: 22%

Vendimia: Variada dependiendo de las variedades pero siempre un poco anticipada.

Temperatura sugerida para consumo: 10° C (50° F)

Alcohol: 12.5%



The rosé wines are distinguished by their colors that can go from a color “eye of partridge” to a salmon-like, to a pale cherry red to a firm pink.

There is no predilection for any variety unless the wine comes from a recognized region, especially from the old continent.

Roses are seasonal wines, consumed mainly in the spring-summer period.

Our ROSÉ wine is made with 4 vinified grapes separately and assembled at the end of the alcoholic fermentation: Pinot Noir 25%, Pinot Meunier 25%, Grenache 40% and Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, all grown in the Guadalupe Valley.

Color

Clear and bright salmon pink with high intensity.

Aroma

Pronounced intensity on the nose. Aroma of mature strawberries, blood orange, kiwi and roses are perceived.

Taste

This Rosé is dry with a medium to high acidity. Notes of strawberries and citrus are confirmed. A harmonious wine with great persistence.

Average brix: 22%

Harvest: Varied depending on the varieties. But always a bit anticipated Suggested serving temperature: 50° F

Alcohol: 12.5%
