



SOLAR FORTUN



OWNER: Lopez-Viana Family WINEMAKER: Santiago Lopez PRODUCTION: 3,200 Cases

Solar Fortun was started in 2008, as a family owned enterprise of the Lopez-Viana Family. Co-founder, Alberto Lopez guides the daily operations of the winery while his U.C. Davis trained son Santiago, handles the winemaking duties. When you consider that Señor Lopez is a well-regarded physicist with a PhD in astrophysics from the U.K. and Santiago, is a former member of Mexico's Olympic Gymnastics Team, they might be one of the region's most interesting winemaking pairs,

Using only grapes grown in a pristine vineyard tucked away within a hidden valley in Francisco Zarco, the portfolio leans towards Rhone inspired red wines. In order to maximize the vineyards potential all of the vines are certified bench grafted from Napa Valley and all of the rootstocks & clones are either American or French. In a relatively short period of time, Solar Fortun has become recognized as a "winery to watch". Considering that the 2014 O Positivo is on the list at The French Laundry and the 2014 Confabulario was named 1 of the Top 10 wines in Mexico, it appears that they can back up that claim on both sides of the border.

High intensity plum and leather aromas dominate this wines first approach, followed closely by purple flowers and herbs as a consecuence of the petit verdot on it. Mid palate is soft and long and expresses a savory personality familiar to Mourvedre. The wine finishes on a fresh, spicy note, reflecting great acidity and permanence.

Winemaker notes

Confabulario is one of our most creative blends, showing the power and richness of petit verdot along with the subtleness of Mourvedre. The leather and smoky notes on this wine reflect the style of high end french premium wines.

Similar to a good garage band, the stark surroundings of an unassuming building which to this day serves as Madera 5's winery, provided the motivation and inspiration to create one of Mexico's most iconic brands. The five partners of Madera 5 started their journey making wine in a garage at Aragón 126 back in 2007, and the name "Madera 5" came after an inside joke involving a good golf story and a 5 wood.

Unpretentious, just like the five amigos, is the best way to describe the style of their award winning wines. Under the guidance of partner & winemaker, Victor Segura (Las Nubes), their affordably priced wines are highly sought after throughout Mexico. Not surprisingly, they have quickly caught on with consumers in the U.S. and their Tempranillo Cabernet is amongst La Competencia's best-selling red wines.

One thing that makes Madera 5 unique from its peers in Valle de Guadalupe is that 100% of their production is derived from grapes sourced from vineyards located south of Ensenada in Valle de San Vicente.

Like numerous other wine fanatics, Roganto began as a hobby between two friends who enjoyed the experimentation, exploration and trial and error that each vintage brings. For close to 15 years, Rogelio Sanchez del Palacio and Antonio Luis Escalante Dominguez enjoyed this noble pursuit with one goal in mind . . .produce a wine that they could enjoy with friends & family. Finally, in 2001, after achieving a loyal following for their "garage wine", they finally took a leap of faith, combined their two first names to come up with "Roganto" and officially launched their brand.

Working from a nondescript building, Roganto gradually built a cult-like following throughout Mexico. A low-key marketing approach helped to foster the legend about the winery and it has been said more than once that "Roganto is like the devil, everyone talks about it but no one has seen it." With an approximate production of 20,000 cases and another 10 hectares in development in Valle de San Jacinto, south of Ensenada between Santo Tomas and San Vicente, there should be plenty of wine available for Roganto's growing customer base in Mexico and the U.S.
