Tasting notes: Great ruby color with a slight hint of pepper and notes of black fruits that remind us of ripe fig, light and spiced at the end with a medium body, balanced and romantic: soft tannins and a slight presence of wood. Surco Rojo is elegant, typical of the fine wines of the Valle de San Vicente.
